The school is a magnet for entrepreneurial activities, attracting professionals from all over China for their Executive MBA, and has become a powerhouse for new business.



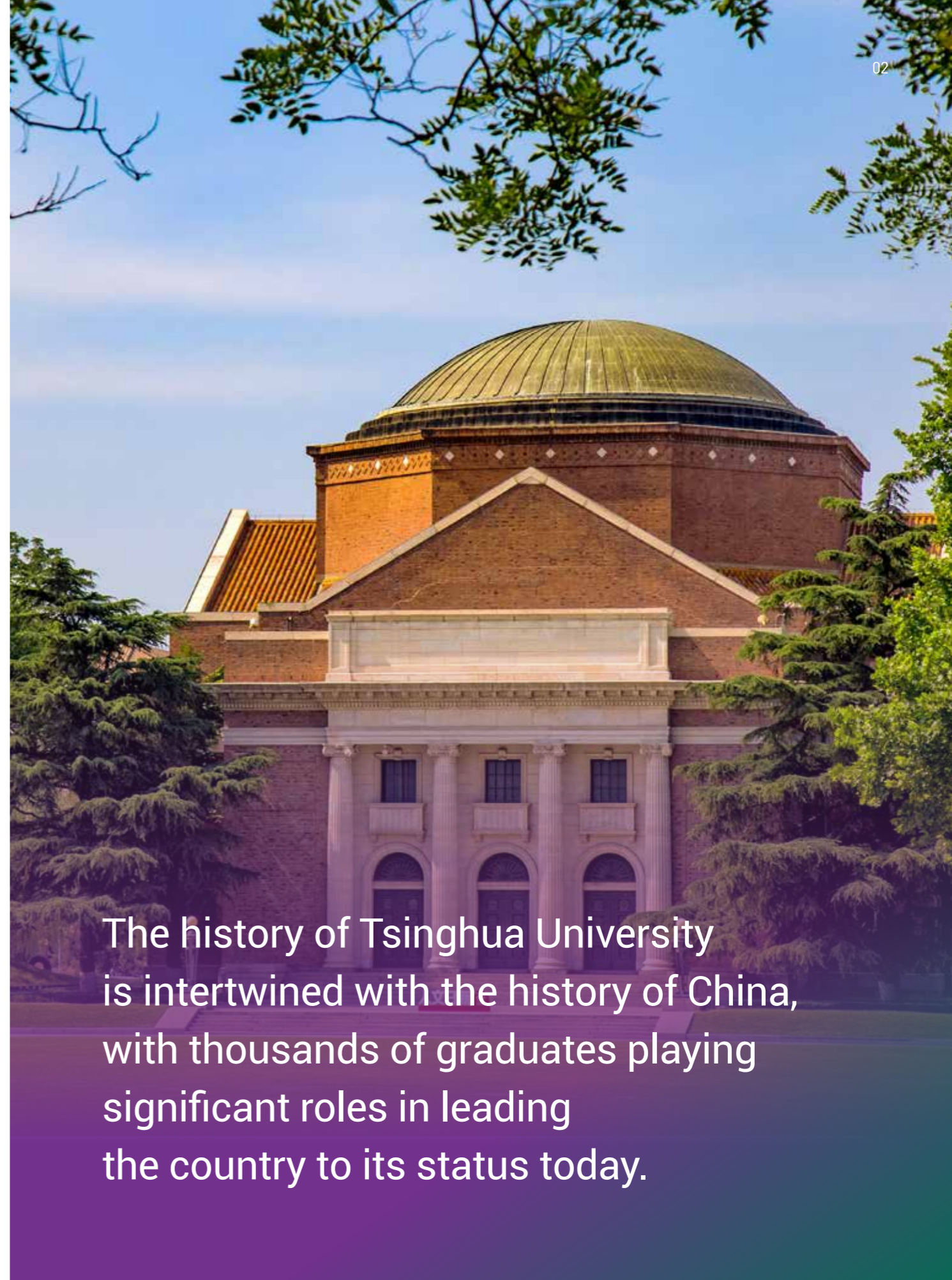

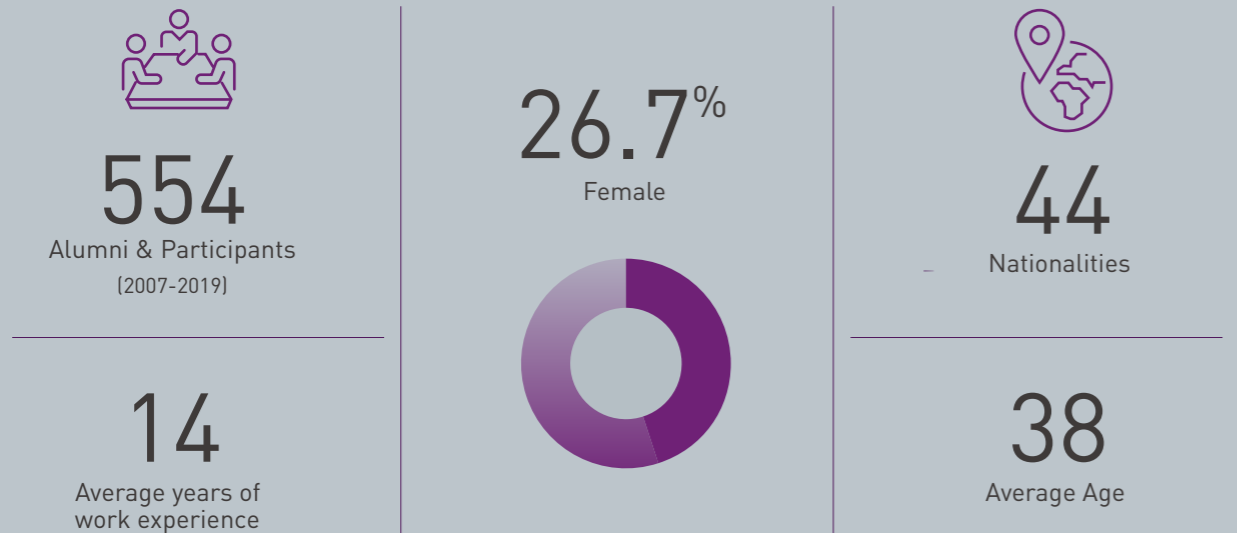

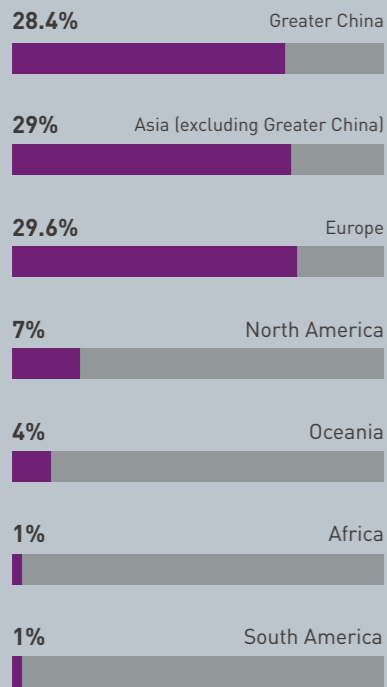
I try to share with my participants the differences in how leadership may have to be approached, taking into account the cultural differences.”



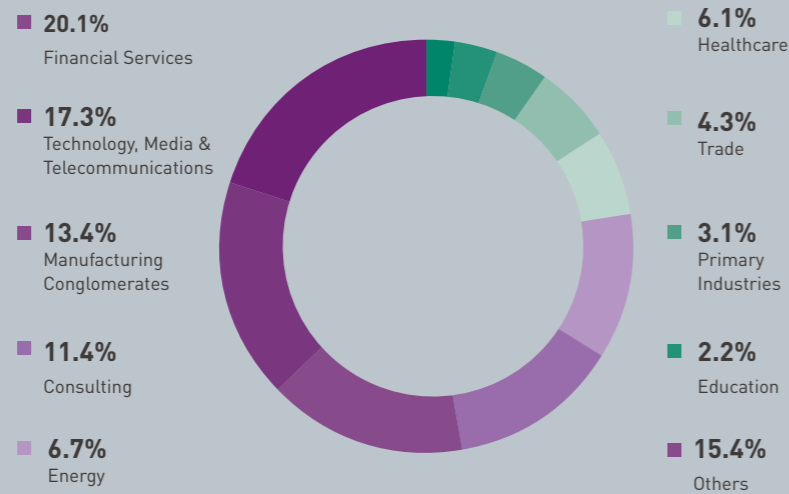

Curriculum

The TIEMBA is designed around several essential components: Core Courses, Elective Courses, Key Management Challenges, the Leadership Development Programme and a Final Thesis. It covers the business school classics as well as the current business and technical trends, with a global vision and a deep understanding of the Chinese context. This curriculum fully embodies the advantages of Tsinghua University as a comprehensive university and INSEAD as a world-leading business school.

Curriculum Design Concept



Core Courses

During the first seven modules, we offer 12 core courses, covering the breadth of key business disciplines. Taught by both Tsinghua and INSEAD faculty and using a variety of teaching styles, these courses will review, revive and expand your understanding. Each course combines business concepts with real-life application.

Elective Courses

Elective courses allow you to delve deeper into topics of your choice. They take place on INSEAD's idyllic Fontainebleau campus over two weeks during the French summer. The TIEMBA class comes together with the INSEAD Global Executive MBA and Executive Master in Finance, as well as alumni of these programmes. This allows for a wider choice of courses and greater networking possibilities. To further enhance professional development, TIEMBA graduates may return after graduation to attend additional electives.

Key Management Challenges

Key Management Challenge (KMC) courses cover broad, multi-disciplinary, whole-company issues and address uncertainty, change and ambiguity in apprehending opened problems. It introduces concepts that integrate technology, society and business. You will also be able to build an in-depth understanding of Chinese economy, including both macro and micro issues and China's financial market.

Developing Reflective Leaders

This is a unique and enriching component that is offered in the programme, thanks to the pioneering work of the INSEAD Global Leadership Centre.

Leadership Development Programme

The Leadership Development Programme (LDP) runs throughout all of the modules and gives you the self-awareness and strategies you need to grow as a leader. Participants are put into a learning group of about four people – selected for their diversity – in which they support, encourage and challenge each other to broaden their behavioural repertoire and develop their own authentic leadership style. Accompanied and guided by a professional executive coach, each group embarks on a journey through many structured activities such as team building experiences and simulations, 360° and progress feedback, individual and group coaching sessions, peer exchanges and communication workshops. There are also live forums with inspiring leaders to expand your networks.



Admissions

For your application to the Tsinghua-INSEAD Executive MBA programme, you will need to follow the steps outlined below. You can submit your application either through the INSEAD or Tsinghua admissions offices. The process is the same and you will be evaluated by both schools.

Application Process

1. Pre-application Assessment

Interested candidates are encouraged to send in their CV for a pre-application assessment by the admission team. You may either email it to tiemba@sem.tsinghua.edu.cn (Tsinghua Admission Team) or tiemba@insead.edu (INSEAD Admission Team).

3. Additional Required Materials:

Two letters of recommendation;
Colour copies of identity documents;
Colour copies of degree(s) either in English or Chinese achieved from all universities attended.
Original copies of official transcripts with grades from all universities attended.

* A non-refundable application fee is required.

5. Chinese Nationals from Mainland China who wish to enroll in an EMBA programme are required by the Ministry of Education, China, to take the National Entrance Exam. You will have to obtain a Conditional Acceptance Letter from TIEMBA Programme before registering online for the National Entrance Exam in October 2020. The actual exam will take place at Tsinghua University in December 2020. We encourage interested applicants to submit your applications early to ensure timely registration of the entrance exam.

Other nationalities besides PRC are required to upload their information with relevant documents and pay the application fee to Tsinghua to verify their qualifications.

2. Complete and Submit the Application Form

You can apply through the online application form on the TIEMBA website: <http://tsinghua.insead.edu/>. You need to answer several essay questions and provide names of two recommenders.

4. Assessment Options:

Option 1: GMAT/Executive Assessment & TIEMBA Interview
Option 2: TIEMBA Written Test & TIEMBA Interview

* Complete applications must be submitted at least two weeks before the test date.



We operate a rolling admission process, offering you a choice of four deadlines. We recommend applying as early as possible and applications will be evaluated as they are submitted.

For reference, the application deadlines for the class starting in September 2021 (and graduating in 2023) are:

1 Round	11 September, 2020	2 Round	21 February, 2021
3 Round	19 March, 2021	4 Round	16 April, 2021

Chinese Language Course

'Master of Chinese' is a course in Tsinghua University and is compulsory for international participants who come to China to undertake a master degree. It gives participants from all over the world an opportunity to learn Chinese language and the culture. Those who successfully complete (32 class hours) and pass this course will earn 2 Credits.

About the Course

Participants will be allocated into different classes according to their Chinese proficiency levels, i.e. Elementary, Intermediate and Advanced Levels.

Exemption

Participants who have learnt Chinese before may be exempted with any of these proofs of language proficiency:

- Provide Chinese Proficiency Test Certificate: Old HSK Level 8, or New HSK Level 6: An overall score of at least 195 with minimum scores of 65 in Listening, Reading and Writing.
- Provide Degree Certificate obtained in Mainland China and taught entirely in Chinese.
